Climate: Martinique has a tropical and humid climate with an average temperature of 28 degrees. It is moderated by trade winds, which bring cool breezes.

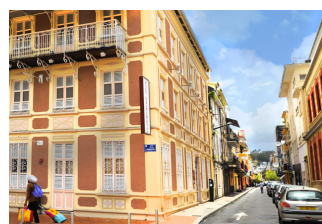
