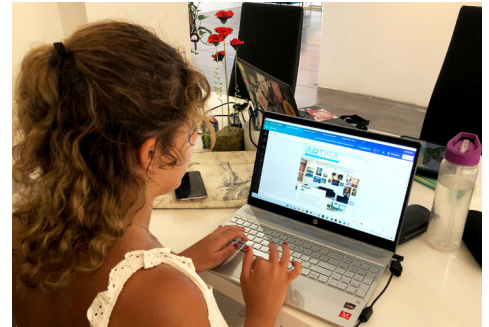
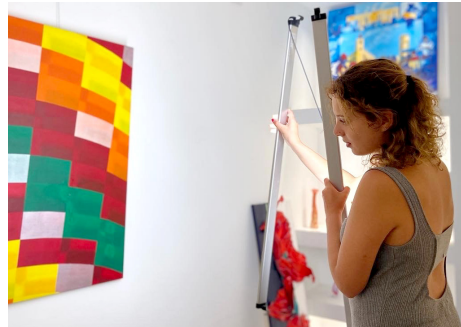


Turing project in Arts ARUBA



the project

Tur Cos Ta Posibel will host volunteers in local community arts activities. Here are two examples of local community organisations you could be involved with.

Arte Sano provides vocational training in the creative industries empowering vulnerable people of Aruba: addicts, youth in prison,

woman in prison. Volunteer tasks includes teaching their artistic skills to Arte Sano's target, with one theme: Aruba.

ArtisA: Volunteers will have the opportunity to support ArtisA in organizing workshops, events, projects while helping to run the gallery and run the social media

of all the platforms of ArtisA. They count on you to bring fresh ideas and together keep developing Aruba into a more Creative Island!

Volunteers will be involved in all activities of both or one of these organisations.

accommodation and meals

Trainees will live in a shared house with other international participants. Rooms will be shared for trainee groups.

Trainees will receive a monthly pocket money as well as a food allowance to be able to buy food and household necessities either individually or as a group.

The accommodation is well located, 5 minutes walk from a local beach and food shop and with all the appliances and

equipment needed for self-catering and learning to cook the local food.

There are 2 shared cars and 2 bikes which can be used by trainees, it is recommended for this project trainees are competent drivers. There is a washing machine and wifi at the house. Trainees are responsible for maintenance of the garden and weekly cleaning of the house.

- A plus is knowledge of Design Programs and WordPress

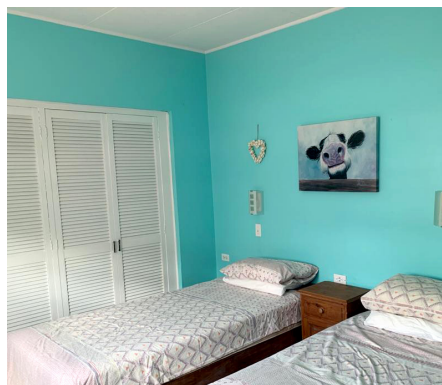

Pos Chiquito where trainees live is a local community towards the south of the island, serviced with a supermarket, laundrette, snack-van and DIY stores for household necessities. There are three restaurants in walking distance. The main tourist attractions are in the North of the island around Palm Beach and Noord where

there is also a large supermarket (Superfoods) worth the drive for a large weekly shop. The capital Oranjestad is a 15 minute drive or 20 minutes on the bus.

Aruba is full of wonderful beaches, Magle Halto is situation 5 minutes from the accommodation and Surfside Beach
